We also understand that neither report cards, transcripts, nor school records will be released until all our financial obligations have been met.
9. We grant permission to school authorities to discipline our child and to allow whatever reasonable disciplinary measures are necessary, including corporal punishment. We further agree to reinforce the discipline of our child in our home. We understand that any student is subject to review for dismissal by the School Board, if necessary. If this is done or our child is withdrawn, we realize that the current month's charges are due and payable, and will not be refunded.
